

Daily Fantasy Sports 2019 Annual Report

Executive Summary:

On July 26, 2017, the Delaware Interactive Daily Fantasy Sports Act was signed into law by Governor John Carney. The Act permits Daily Fantasy Sports participants, in Delaware, to wager on the performance of players the participant selected for their roster based on the participant's skill and knowledge. The Delaware Division of Gaming Enforcement has the regulatory oversight to ensure the integrity, accountability and public trust of these contests.

Amendments to Original Legislation: None

Approved Registered Operators:

The Division of Gaming Enforcement completed suitability backgrounds on the following Daily Fantasy Sports Operators and have approved for operations in Delaware. The registration dates are valid as long as the annual \$50,000 registration fee and quarterly State taxes have been paid. Yahoo applied to be an operator and was approved in late in 2019.

- Draft Kings – Registered until September 4, 2021.
- Draft – Registered until September 4, 2021.
- FanDuel – Registered until November 20, 2021.
- Yahoo Fantasy Sports – Registered July 8, 2019 – July 8, 2022.

Taxes and Fees: The taxes and fees for all registered operators have been paid.

Registrants Annual Report Submission:

According to the Delaware Interactive Daily Fantasy Sports Act, 29 *Del. C.* § 4867, registered operators are required to submit the following information to Director of the Division of Gaming Enforcement:
